

Statement of the National Institution for Human Rights on the death of three policemen

National Institution for Human Rights strongly condemns the illegal acts witnessed by the Kingdom of Bahrain on Monday, March 3, 2014, which targeted the lives of security men and innocent people, destabilized the security and stability, terrorized innocent citizens and residents and threatened national peace and security.

National Institution for Human Rights expresses its deep sorrow and regret for the death of three security men as a result of the explosion which occurred in Aldaih area while they were securing the roads and the protecting citizens and public and private properties.

National Institution for Human Rights also extends condolences and sympathy to the families of the security men, praying to the Almighty to inspire their families patience and fortitude, and wish a speedy recovery to the injured in this tragic incident.
