

**ROYAL ORDER NO. (22) OF 2021
TO APPOINT MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE NATIONAL INSTITUTION FOR HUMAN RIGHTS**

We, Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, King of the Kingdom of Bahrain,

After reviewing the Constitution,

And Law No. (26) of 2014 on the Establishment of the National Institution for human rights,
amendment by Decree-Law No. (20) of 2016,

And Royal Order No. (17) of 2017 on determination of the selection process of members of the
Council of Commissioners in the National Institution for Human Rights,

And Royal Order No. (23) of 2017 to appoint members of the Council of Commissioners of the
National Institution for Human Rights,

And Royal Order No. (36) of 2019 to appoint members of the Council of Commissioners of the
National Institution for Human Rights,

And based on consultations with the relevant civil society institutions,

Herby order the following:

Their term of office shall be four years, renewable.
