

Statement by NIHR on the Arab Day for Human Rights

Manama on March 16, 2021

The Arab Human Rights Committee (the Charter Committee) of the League of Arab States celebrates the Arab Day of Human Rights on the 16th of March each year, the anniversary of the entry into force of the Arab Charter on Human Rights in 2008, after being adopted in Tunis Summit, in order to highlight the achievements of Arab countries in the human rights field, through constructive cooperation and joint efforts.
