

National Institution for Human Rights is following up the cases of dismissed employees

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The National institution for Human Rights is following up the cases of the suspended employees or those dismissed in the public and private sectors closely as this constitutes major concern to the Bahraini family contrasts with the directives of the country's Monarch, His Majesty King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa, the Prime Minister, His Royal Highness Prince Khalifa bin Salman Al Khalifa, and the Crown Prince, His Royal Highness Prince Salman bin Hamad Al-Khalifa calling for national dialogue and creating a climate supportive of this initiative.

Within the framework of its national duty and responsibility, the NIHR calls on the public and private sectors to speed up decision-making concerning the cases of suspended and dismissed employees based on the decision of the Prime Minister, HH Prince Khalifa bin Salman Al Khalifa, on the formation of a committee to consider ceasing staff suspension and dismissal in the public and private sectors, and speed up decision-making on their cases.

The NIHR also urges the public and private sectors to speed up the process of taking legal actions to determine legal position of the employee and consider reducing the number of dismissal cases unless it is proven any employee committed offenses punishable under the relevant laws. This is in line with the NIHR's keenness on the importance of the need to respect all the rights of employees in the public and private sectors, which are guaranteed in the Constitution and legislation in force.
