

Statement of the NIHR on the Occasion of United Nations Day

Manama – 24 October 2025

On the occasion of United Nations Day, the countries of the world, including the Kingdom of Bahrain, celebrate this event on the 24th of October each year to highlight the vital role of the United Nations in promoting international peace and security, protecting human rights, and achieving sustainable development. This day embodies the international community's affirmation of the importance of cooperation and solidarity among nations to build a world that is more just and stable. It also serves as an opportunity to recall the founding principles of the United Nations and to reaffirm the collective commitment to continue striving toward its noble goals in serving humanity and promoting universal values.

The United Nations has designated this year's theme as "The United Nations at 80: Building Our Future Together", reflecting its eight-decade journey in serving humanity and advancing peace, human rights, and sustainable development. This year's celebration comes amid the rapid global transformations taking place, as the United Nations continues its efforts to build a more inclusive, just, and stable world for future generations.
