



Statement by the NIHR on the Occasion of the United Nations Day

Manama on October 24, 2021

On October 24 every year, the National Institution for Human Rights (NIHR) joins all countries of the world in the celebration of the United Nations Day, which marks the anniversary of the United Nations Charter, which has been in force since 1945, and represents an opportunity to affirm the importance of everyone following the noble values and lofty goals for which the United Nations was established.
